

Clout Shoot – 23rd May 2015

10:00 Start

A Flag is placed in the ground at set distance from the shooting line (e.g. 180 yards) and the archers commence shooting at that flag, after shooting has finished a special rope is attached to the flag which is then stretched out to its fullest extent where the scoring zones marked on the rope can then be clearly seen, the rope is then slowly moved around the flag at full tension in a circle with each arrow falling under each scoring zone being picked up by the person responsible for that scoring zone, once the scoring arrows have been accounted for they are all laid out in their respective scoring zone along the rope and then the archers owning those arrows can score them in descending order and remove them.

There can be more than one flag set out for different categories of archers.
