Charity / Fun Shoot

The Burntwood Rounds in target archery are mainly used by Visually Impaired archers but can be used by any archer in target archery.

The distance of shooting is set at 30 meters and the target face size is changed instead of altering the shooting distance.

The Burntwood National round will be shot starting at 4 dozen arrows at 30meters on to a 60cm face, then 2 dozen at 80cm face shot at 30 meters distance using the 5 zone scoring.

Ends of six arrows will be shot.

This would be a fun shoot for Compound and Recurve archers, using the 40cm / 60cm faces. Longbow Archers are invited to shoot this in competition, there will be some form of trophy/medals to shoot for.

This will be Charity shoot and a donation probably £2:00.is kindly requested for entry. All donations are expected to be given to N.S.R.D.A.

Longbow archers could find this good practice as the distance is set at 30 meters.

A small Buffet is hoping to be arranged after the shoot.
